



## **UL and STAMEQ Sign Renewed and Expanded Agreement to Promote National Safety Standards for Vietnam**

In September 2016, UL and the national standards body of Vietnam (STAMEQ) signed a renewed and expanded agreement to collaborate on safety requirements and to allow for the adoption of UL Standards by STAMEQ.

The agreement provides STAMEQ with full access to all UL standards, and encourages the translation, use, and adoption of UL standards within Vietnam. In addition, the agreement encourages cooperation and collaboration between UL and STAMEQ on safety related standards issues.
